Event Format	<p>The CAA End of Season Shoot is an informal tournament designed to offer a friendly introduction to competitive archery. It is open to all CAA-affiliated members, irrespective of age, ability or experience. Whilst age-appropriate rounds are shown below for guidance, archers are encouraged to select a round they feel confident in shooting. Final scores will be subject to handicap adjustment, allowing all archers to compete fairly against one another.</p> <p>Albion (Long Windsor) - 80/60/50 yds</p> <p>Recommended for: Men (50+, Senior, U21, U18) and Women (50+, Senior, U21)</p> <p>Windsor - 60/50/40yds</p> <p>Recommended for: Men (50+, Senior, U21, U18, U16) and Women (50+, Senior, U21, U18)</p> <p>Windsor 50 - 50/40/30 yds</p> <p>Recommended for: Men (U16, U15) and Women(U18, U16, U15)</p> <p>Windsor 40 - 40/30/20 yds</p> <p>Recommended for: Men (U15, U14) and Women (U16, U15, U14)</p> <p>Windsor 30 - 30/20/10 yds</p> <p>Recommended for: Men(U14, U12) and Women (U14, U12)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">● All rounds will be shot in a rolling detail of 6 arrows per end.● All rounds will be shot on 122cm full faces, using 5-zone scoring	

Event Timings	Gates open from 8:30. Registration from 09:00. Equipment Inspection from 09:30. Assembly 10:15. Sighters 10:30.
Registration	Membership cards will be required for registration. If you are not yet in possession of a 2023/2024 card, please bring proof that you have paid your membership to your club.
Bow inspection	Equipment inspection will be carried out prior to the start of practice.
Awards	Medals will be awarded for Senior Men/Women and Junior Men/Women categories. Results will be determined based on adjusted scores.
Shooting Rules	Archery GB Rules of shooting will apply throughout. Archery GB or their Agents and servants cannot accept liability. AGB Membership cards (Physical or Digital) must be produced at registration.
Dress regulations	Please refer to Archery GB's rules of shooting for dress regulations (rule 307 will apply). Archers should comply with dress regulations until after the presentations.
Lost Arrows	Lost arrows must be reported to a judge or member of the field party (please remember to inform them if you later find the arrow). It is the archer's responsibility to account for all arrows before leaving the field. *Please be aware that due to our shooting venue being a multi-sport field the use of full carbon arrows is prohibited.
Photography	In line with Archery GB policy, anyone wishing to take video or photographs during the event must register their details with tournament organiser. If parents/carers have any concerns about their child/young person being photographed or filmed they should notify the organisers. The organisers reserve the right to decline entry to any person unable to meet or abide by these conditions.
Refreshments	Sam's Thai food truck will be on site from 12:00 offering stir-fry selection and warming curries. Each main meal costs £10 and is served with a choice of rice or noodles. In order to help minimise waste and keep things running smoothly, a pre-order system is in operation (No pre-payment required). Both card and cash are accepted on the day. Light refreshments including tea, coffee and a modest selection of cakes will be made available throughout the day. Unfortunately, we are only able to support cash payment at this time.
Bosses	All rounds will be shot on Ten Zone Layered foam bosses
Special Note	Please ensure that the organiser is aware of any special requirements you may have. Archers who are unable to get to the target are requested, if possible, to arrange for an agent to aid in scoring and arrow collection. If this is not possible, please contact the organiser for advice.
Liability	The club cannot accept any responsibility for any loss damage or injury however caused. Entry to the tournament will be taken as acceptance of these conditions.
Smoking	Smoking and vaping is not permitted on the field of play. Please use the designated smoking area located in the main carpark.
Parking	Limited car park and bicycle parking is available at the venue. Please do not block the chained area - this is for ambulance access.
Documentation	Archery GB GDPR compliance statement: When you enter competitions the following information may be collected and shared with tournament organisers, scoring systems and other competitors for example target lists and results may be published: First Name, Surname, Gender, Bow style, Date of Birth / Age category, Email, Address, Phone number, Club (and ID), County (and ID), Region (and ID), Round (unless defined by age), Disabled (Y/N), Disability info." Target lists, results and other instructions will be available via Netherhall Archers (netherhall-archers.org).
